ZEIC Lands Trio of Economic Development Leaders

Today the Zero Emissions Innovation Centre (ZEIC) welcomed three new recruits who will apply their extensive expertise, relationships, and knowledge of the energy transition to advance the Centre's new Economic Development and Market Transformation initiatives.

Until recently, the trio—**George Patrick Richard Benson**, **Peter Sun**, and **Andrew Williamson**—worked at the Vancouver Economic Commission. Following a planned phase-down process, the City of Vancouver is closing that agency and centralizing its role within a new Business and Economy Office. As of today, Benson, Sun, and Williamson are full-time ZEIC employees.

"We're delighted to have these three decarbonization champions on our team," said Melina Scholefield, Executive Director of ZEIC. "Each of them brings specialized skills and knowledge on how to effectively and thoughtfully accelerate this region's transition to prosperous, equitable, and zero-emissions communities."

The trio will report to Namendra Anand, ZEIC's Director of Business Strategy and Impact Investing. Anand is leading ZEIC's work on climate action strategies that transform markets and leverage sustainable finance to create low-carbon economic development opportunities.
